Our number one priority is the safety and well-being of our staff and residents.

As advised by phone to next of kin family members on Saturday, we were advised that a staff member at Bexley Aged Care Home had tested positive to COVID-19. This staff member did not have any symptoms and was subject to routine testing every 72 hours.

We are pleased to advise that after further testing, this staff member has returned three negative tests and the Public Health Unit have now cleared the home of any outbreak. We now believe that the initial positive test was a false positive.

The Home remains in lockdown to all non-essential visitors due to the current stay-at-home orders.
