Dear Karingal Green resident family members

Our number one priority is the safety and well-being of our residents and staff.

We have been advised by the Public Health Unit (PHU) that an agency staff member has returned a positive result to COVID-19. This person worked at Karingal Green on 15 February, we have not been advised if they were infectious during their shift. As a precaution we have implemented our Outbreak Management Plan and have started Rapid Antigen Testing all staff before they commence their shift.

We currently have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 at Karingal Green. The home is calm and our residents are being monitored closely, all residents are asymptomatic.

As Karingal Green is a large home we are implementing extra protections around visitors during this period. To assist in maintaining our screening on entry process from 22 February we will commence Rapid Antigen Testing on all visitors and have dedicated visiting hours as per below, this will allow us all to stay safe. As per the advice from the Premier there is also a limit on the number of fully vaccinated visitors allowed to four (4) per resident per day, exemptions apply for compassionate reasons.
